PARIS EXPERIENCE

DAY 1

Morning departure from your school by executive coach. Travel to your centre in Paris via shuttle or ferry arriving in time for dinner. Free time after dinner to explore your surroundings.

DAY 2

After breakfast, your group will depart for a full-day excursion. Your coach will collect an official (English speaking) guide who will conduct a panoramic tour of the main tourist sites lasting approximately three hours.

After eating their packed lunch, your group will visit the Eiffel Tower taking the lift to the second stage. From there, your pupils will enjoy the spectacular views from the city's most famous landmark, and then embark on a one hour boat trip on the River Seine. Following dinner at your centre you will visit the Sacre Couer and Montmartre.

DAY 3

Depart after breakfast for the journey home (a packed lunch will be provided by the centre to eat en route). Before leaving Paris, there will be a stop at Notre Dame before returning via Shuttle or Ferry to arrive early evening back at your school.

DAY 1

Depart from your school by executive coach and travel to Calais via ferry or shuttle. On arrival in Calais, the coach will take the autoroute to your chosen centre to arrive in time for dinner. Following dinner there is time to explore the locality.

DAY 2

In the morning, your group will travel to Peronne to discover the Historial de la Grande Guerre, a must-see museum dedicated to the history of the First World War

Your group will then take a 3 hour guided tour of battlefields, trenches and memorials of WW1. Following dinner there is a visit to the historic town of Arras.

DAY 3

Depart after breakfast with packed lunch provided for the journey home. On the way home you will visit the amazing V1 and V2 German Rocket site at La Coupole. Travel via Shuttle or Ferry to arrive late evening back at your school.

DAY 1
